



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Community Map




What is the Open Space?

- Parkwoode Shores owns over 100 acres of 'open space' that is shared for the use of all 168 homeowners in PSHA.
- ► This includes over 1 mile of lakefront property on Woodhull Lake, and 1 lakefront lot on Eagle lake, commonly known as 'the peninsula.'
- Most of the open space is in its natural form, much like a state park. There are open prairies, wooded trails, a wildflower garden & butterfly sanctuary.

- ► Easements are marked with pavers near the sidewalk




Butterfly Sanctuary & Wildflower Garden (2014)



Lake Access

- PSHA has over 1 mile of shoreline on Woodhull lake. Small watercraft can be launched from many locations, but motorized vehicles are not allowed on the open space.
- PSHA does not have a private boat ramp, but larger boats can be launched at the DNR boat ramp on Lake Oakland
- All PSHA members are eligible to become members of Lakeland Estates to gain access to their beach and boat ramp on Eagle Lake for an additional \$60/year fee (paid to Lakeland Estates).
